

# REQUEST FOR CONFIRMATION CERTIFICATE

(Certificate required for marriage purposes)

N.B. Note that in the Confirmation Register, the Father's Surname may not have been entered as it was understood to be the same surname as the Child. (Example: Child's name "John Murphy"; Father's name "Patrick"; Mother's name "Mary Smith" – under "Parents' Names", entry may read "Patrick & Mary Smith". This should be written on the Certificate as "Patrick Murphy & Mary Smith")

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<sup>\*1</sup> The Confirmation Register records the Date of Baptism (not Birth). However, this date is useful if Date of Baptism is not known.

<sup>\*2</sup> The Confirmation Register does not record the address at the time of Baptism or Confirmation, but the Certificate of Confirmation requires address "residing at" \_\_\_\_\_
